


Develop Leadership & Mentoring Skills

through interactions with Panchayat leaders and participation in village systems and projects.






Foster Empathy & Cultural Sensitivity

ENGAGE IN TEACHING AND MENTORING


Develop students' leadership and mentoring skills by teaching practical English and public speaking to younger government school students fostering empowerment through education.

Through direct involvement in teaching, mentoring and rural projects, students will understand the impact of service, and the value of contributing meaningfully to society.






PROBLEM-SOLVING


